PARENTS/CARERS

As a parent of a pupil at Southery Academy I/we will:

- Make sure my child attends regularly and notify the academy of reasons for any absence
- Try to avoid taking my child out of the academy for family holidays during term time
- Make sure my child arrives on time at the agreed time.
- Please be aware that the school will be shut and secure, so children will not be allowed into school if late.
- Encourage my child to read and hear him/her read on a regular basis
- Support my child's learning ensuring the completion of any home learning set
- Support the academy in maintaining high standards of behaviour in line with the academies behaviour policy
- Ensure my/our own behaviour and language whilst in the school or its grounds demonstrates respect for others, including appropriate social distancing, and the older children set a good example for younger children
- Respond to any reasonable requests by the academy to discuss my child's education, including behaviour.
- Ensure my child follows the academies uniform guidelines



- Demonstrate a positive attitude towards the academy and respect for the adults working there
- Be respectful of staff, pupils, other parents and the community on social media.
